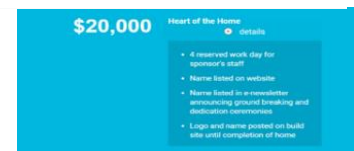

The COVID-19 pandemic has taken its toll on all of us, especially non-profit organizations. Construction costs continue to increase, but that can't stop our mission. We need your support more than ever to continue building homes and hope here in Kenosha.

Thus far this year our organization has:

- Engaged 190 community volunteers who dedicated over 4,322 volunteer hours
- Completed 2 more new home builds here in Kenosha (2215 67th St and 2018 45th St)
- Started 2 more new home builds here in Kenosha (5503 23rd Ave and 5311 17th Ave)
- Successfully held the first ever Women Build Week

Our 2021 goals include:

- Raising \$150,000 - funds to build 1 new home in Kenosha
- Complete the 2 homes started in Fall of 2020
- Build 2 new homes, start to finish – breaking ground in Spring of 2021
- Break ground on 2 new home builds in Fall of 2021
- Raising \$250,000 - allowing us to open the doors of a Kenosha ReStore

Habitat for Humanity of Kenosha can only achieve its goals with the assistance of generous donations from members of our community, like **you**.
