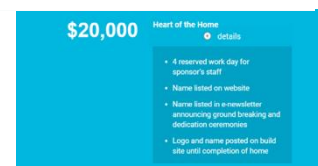

## welcome back ...

We are excited to welcome all volunteers back to our build sites starting Mon, July 6th. With our welcome, we ask that you help us keep everyone safe by following the regulations that we have implemented:

1. We have limited our build site to 10 volunteers a day, including our Carpenter’s Club.
2. We ask that you follow the CDC recommendations and social distance (6ft apart).
3. We have supplied sanitizer at the build sites and we ask that you use it frequently.
4. We ask that you wear a mask while volunteering. If you have your own, please bring it!
5. We ask that you sanitize shared tools after each use. Feel free to bring your own tools.

These regulations have been put in place for the safety of all.

Thank you for your willingness to comply in order to do our best to keep everyone safe.

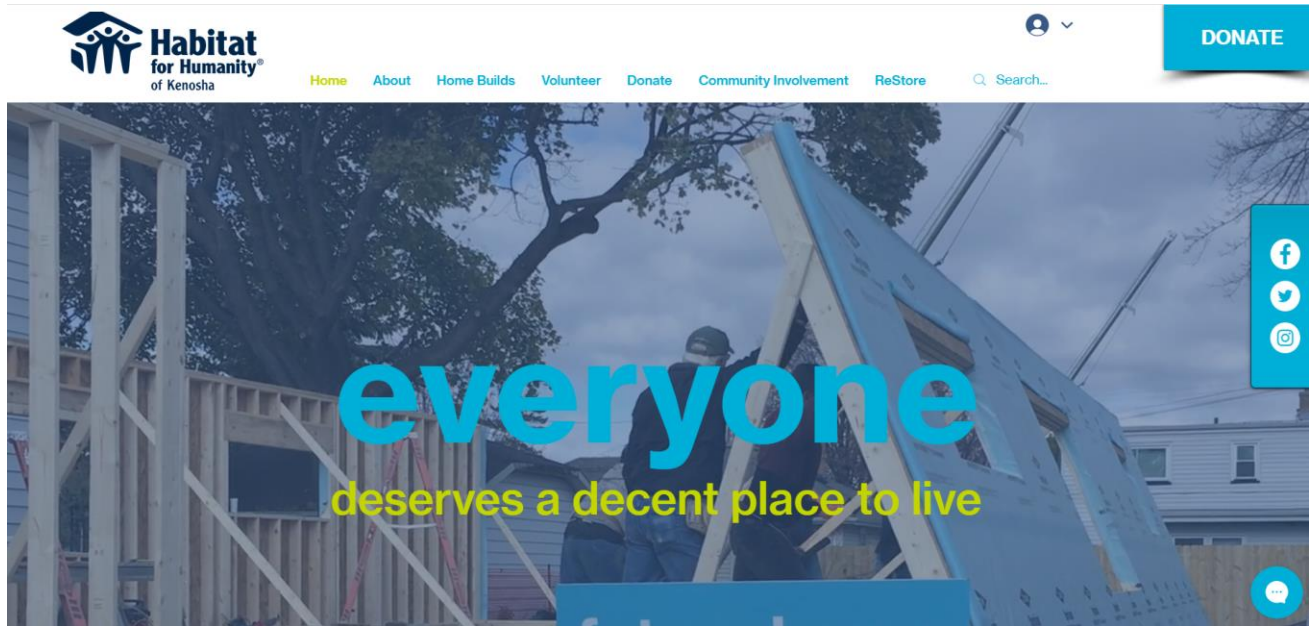
